

INFORMATION REGARDING THE COMMERCIAL OFFER AT ARNOLDSTEIN ENTRY – March 2021

In execution of the project "TAG reverse flow" and according to the <u>Austrian Gas Market Model Ordinance GMMO-VO</u> §3.(1), TAG GmbH will adjust the commercial offer of transportation capacity at the Interconnection Point Arnoldstein Entry and switch from Dynamically Allocable Capacity (DZK) to Freely Allocable Capacity (FZK) from 01.04.2021 06:00.

Pursuant to the <u>Gas System Charges Ordinance</u>, the regulated tariff will be set to 0.97 €/kWh/h/year for FZK capacity and its corresponding interruptible (UK) capacity.

As of 01.04.2021 06:00, only FZK and UK CAM standard capacity products will be offered by TAG on the PRISMA platform, whereby capacity will be bundled with SNAM's Tarvisio Exit capacity to the maximum possible extent, in line with GMMO-VO §4(1).

The first auction for FZK capacity will take place for the transportation period April 2021 (monthly auction starting on 15.03.2021 09:00). Capacity amounts to be offered in the coming auctions can be found on TAG GmbH's website.
